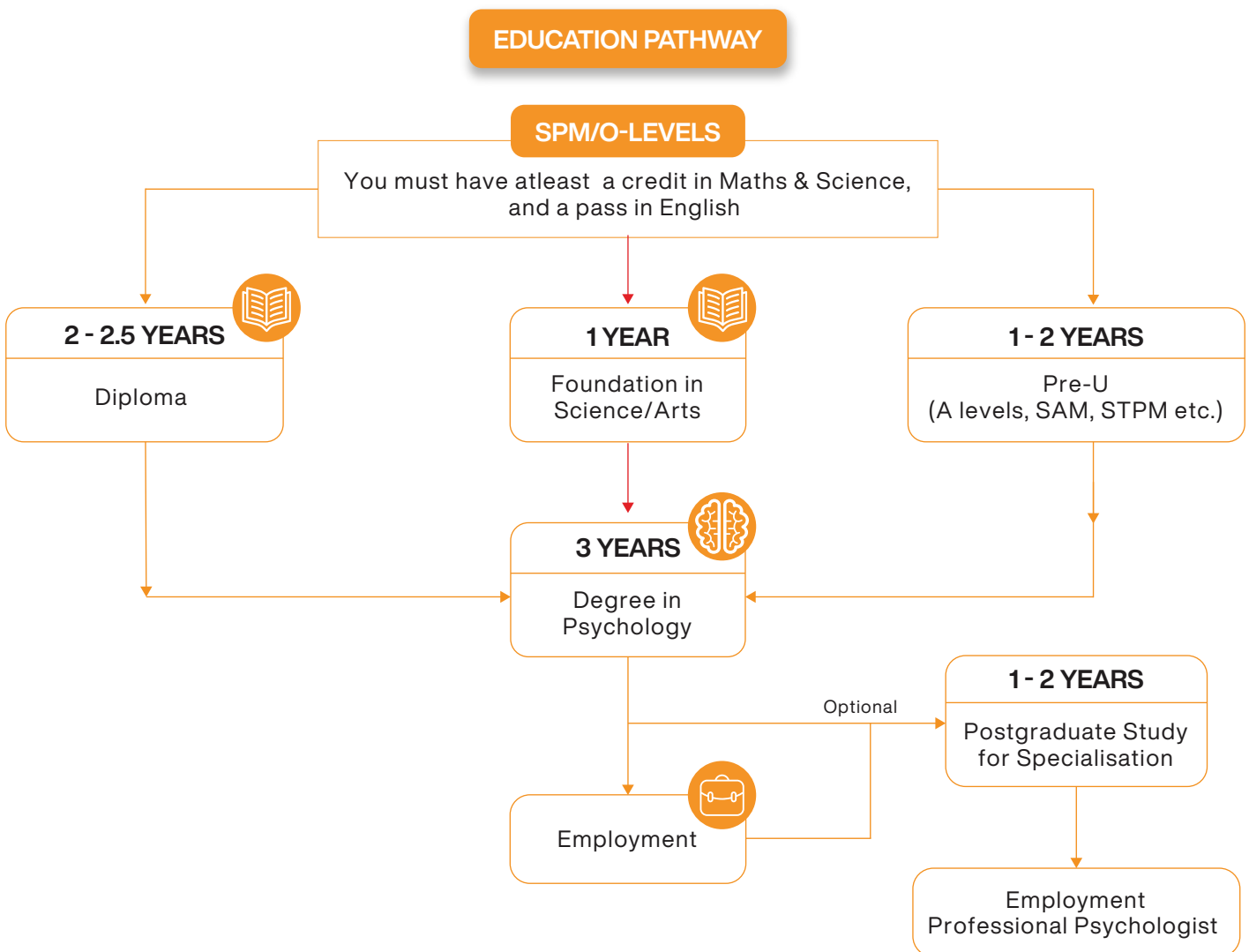
OVERVIEW

Biological Psychology



Studies the biology of behaviour; focuses on the nervous system, hormones and genetics.

Clinical Psychology



Assessment and treatment of mental illness and behavioural problems.

Counselling Psychology



A broader spectrum branch that uses psychological principles to enhance and promote the positive growth, well-being, and mental health of individuals, families, groups, and the broader community.

Cognitive Psychology



Focuses on motivation, problem-solving, decision-making, learning, memory, and more.

Educational Psychology



Studies how people learn, including teaching methods, instructional processes, and individual differences in learning.

Forensic Psychology



Combination of the practice of Psychology and Law. Those who work in this field utilize psychological expertise as it applies to the justice system.

Industrial and Organisational Psychology



Psychological theories and principles to organizations. This field focuses on increasing workplace productivity and related issues such as the physical and mental well-being of employees.
