### Biological Psychology

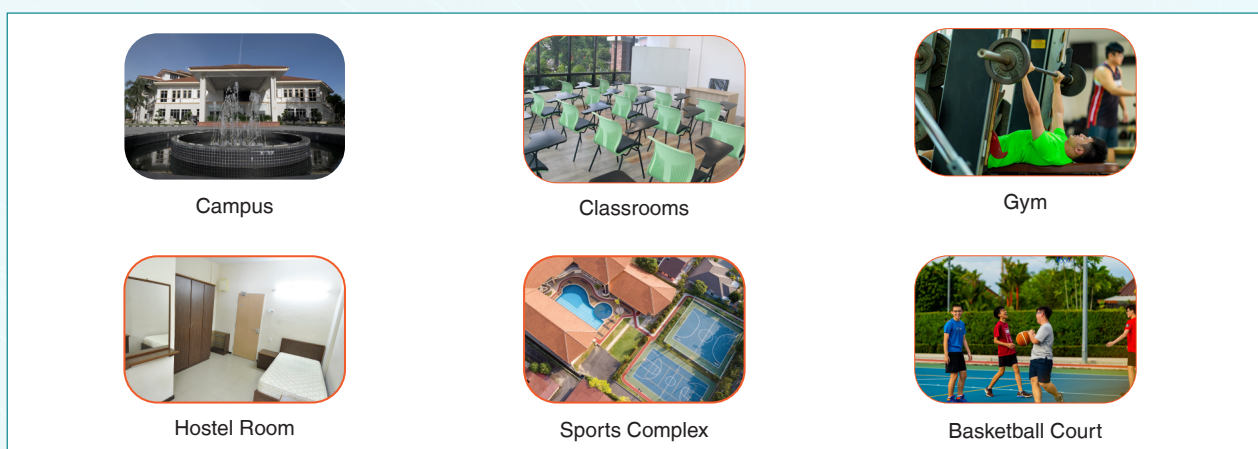
## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

*Diploma	Minimum CGPA 2.00 out of 4.00
Diploma in Psychology	Minimum CGPA 2.00 out of 4.00
Indian Pre-University / All India Senior School Certificate awarded by CBSE / HSCC / HSSC / HSC (Standard XII)	The applicant must Pass the Pre-University (Plus 2) and achieve CGPA 2.00 out of 4.00
Other Qualification	Case-by-case basis to be reviewed by Manipal University College Malaysia Senate or Malaysian Government.
